OCEAN YACHT RACE.

The occean yacht race, arranged by the Geelong Yacht Club, for a 60 guinea cup, presented by Mr. S. Daly, editor of the American yachting paper, "The Rudder," has been fixed for Boxing Day. The club will undertake the whole management of the race, which will start from Port Phillip Heads, the proposal to start the boats from Geelong being considered impracticable, owing to the risk of easterly winds hampering the departure of the boats from the bay.
