SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

(To be read in conjunction with Alpha Course Season 2019/20 Supplementary Sailing Instructions)

1. THE COURSE signified by **Numeral Pennant '7'**




Refer to Alpha Course Supplementary Sailing Instructions 2019/20 season for approx. mark co-ordinates.

Mark	Pass on Hand:
Start Mark - Red/White inflatable buoy.	
No. 9 – 10 Hopetoun	Gate
No.1 – 2 Hopetoun	Gate
Wilson Spit Beacon	Port
Richards Channel North Cardinal Mark	Port
Orange Inflatable Mark - Approx. 200 mtrs South No 2 Point Richards Channel	Starboard
Finish Mark - Red/White inflatable buoy.	

2. THE START

2.1 The starting line will be situated approx. 300 mtrs to the North of the RGYC marina or closer to Pt. Henry if required to clear shipping.

2.2 COMBINED START

Division/Class	Class Flag	Warning Signal
Divisions One, Two, Three and Corio Cruisers	Flag "J" 	10:55 hrs.

3. THE FINISH

3.1 The finishing line will be situated approx. 300 mtrs North of the Portarlington marina.

3.2 Should NO finishing line be in position, boats shall take their own finishing time as they cross an imaginary line extending no more than 100 metres from the North-West corner of the Portarlington pier. This time is to be lodged in writing at RGYC Office, or by email to info@rgyc.com.au as soon as possible but no later than the Protest Time Limit.

4. TIME LIMIT

4.1 The time limit for boats to sail the course and finish is 1800 hours. If no boat has sailed the course and finished within the time limit the race shall be abandoned.

4.2 The Race Committee shall remain on-station at the finish line for 2 hours after the first boat finishes. Boats finishing after that time shall take their own times in accordance with Clause 3.2

4.3 Boats still racing when the time limit expires will be scored TLE as per Alpha Supplementary Sailing Instruction 10 (b). This changes RRS 35, A4.2 and A5

5. PROTESTS and REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

The protest time limit is 1200 hours, Monday 4th November 2019.
