1. ELIGIBILITY

Entry will be accepted for boats which have a safety declaration of compliance as per A.S. Special Regulations, Part 1, for racing boats Category 6 plus VHF Radio.

2. THE COURSE signified by **Numeral Pennant ‘7’**

- (b) In the advent of adverse weather courses may be substituted for published Club Courses as per the 2019/20 Supplementary Sailing Instructions. Signified by Flag 3rd substitute with three sound signals displayed on the flag pole located in the North-West corner of the Club’s property.

3. THE START

3.1 The starting line will be situated approx. 300 mtrs to the North of the RGYC marina.

3.2 Start Order

4. THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between the staff displaying an orange flag at the Signal Box and a Yellow Inflatable Buoy laid approx. 50 mtrs to the North-East of the Signal Box.

This changes RRS S 11.1.

The Race Committee Vessel may be on station adjacent to the Signal Box.

5. TIME LIMIT

5.1 The time limit for boats to sail the course and finish is 1800 hours. If no boat has sailed the course and finished within the time limit the race shall be abandoned.

5.2 Any boats still racing when the time limit expires will be scored TLE as per Alpha Supplementary Sailing Instruction 10 (b). This changes RRS 35, A4.2 and A5
