



OTB Casual Race Entry Process

Boats can compete in the Saturday OTB racing in one of two ways;

1. Complete the on-line entry. This is available only to RGYC members.
2. Complete the on-line casual entry. This is available to RGYC members and visiting sailors who are members of an Australian Sailing affiliated club.

The Casual Entry Process is:

STEP 1: Either visit the Club website, and go to <https://rgyc.com.au/on-water/rgyc-current-sailing-season/> and scroll and click to “OTB Casual Entry link”. Alternatively, scan this QR code.



STEP 2: You will be taken to the Trybooking entry page to register and pay for your casual racing for the day.

STEP 3: Complete all fields on the entry page and progress to the payment page to finalise your entry.

Important information:

1. The cost is \$20 per day. Payments must be completed through the Trybooking entry page.
2. Casual entry competitors will not accrue any points from the day's racing and will not be able to enter the full season series.
3. Casual entrant's finishing position may be acknowledged in the post racing formalities within the Clubhouse.
4. Casual entries must be completed by 12:00 hrs on the day of the race.
5. Supporting documentation and certification may be requested prior to racing.
6. Sailing Instructions are available for viewing and downloading from the aforementioned “Racing Documents” webpage.
