Royal Geelong Yacht Club Yard Rules

Use of the slipway is restricted to vessels of less than 15 tonnes total weight.

- (1) It is the boat owner/owners representative who is responsible for adjusting the designated cradle to suit their boat, this includes greasing wheel bearings.
- (2) The winch operator conducting the slip operation is the final authority on whether to proceed or not. Boat owners/owners representatives of vessels being slipped will respond to the directions of the winch operator.
- (3) It is the responsibility of the boat owner/owners representative to ensure that the wash down area is cleaned after use.
- (4) It is the responsibility of the boat owner/owners representative to ensure that the area of yard occupied is kept clean during yard storage and is cleaned after the boat has been returned to the water. The area must be cleaned daily before the owner/owners representative leaves the premises.
- (5) Any damage occurring to other vessels as a result of work carried out in the yard is to be made good by the offending boat owner/owners representative, eg. paint overspray, anti-foul dust, etc. Any dispute resulting from such circumstances will be arbitrated by the Yard/Marina Committee or, if necessary, by the Board.
- (6) The boat owner is responsible for returning the empty cradle to the designated storage area.
- (7) Boat owners wishing to use contractors to work on their boats whilst in the yard shall ensure that the contractors are registered with the Marina Office prior to commencing any work.
