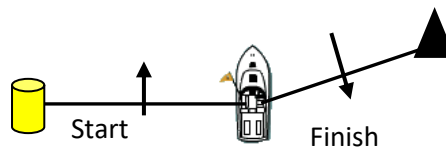
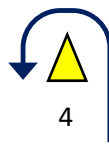

## 2 Course

- 2.1 The course flag shall be numeral pennant 2.
- 2.2 If Mark 5 is not in place, boats shall use mark 3 as their leeward mark.
- 2.3 The course, marks and mark rounding order are described below.



All marks shall be left to port.

Class	Mark Rounding Order
I14	Start – 4 – 5 – 4 – 5 – 4 - Finish
Mark	Description
Start	Yellow pencil
3	Orange cylinder
4	Yellow cone
5	Yellow cone
Finish	Black cone
