Sign On/Off & Crew Declaration

 SIGN ON & OFF and CREW DECLARATION procedures are clearly stated in your Sailing Instructions


• All vessels, as required by your SI, shall radio on when leaving, and off when returning, to the marina.

• Failure to sign on, off or submit a crew declaration may result in a DSQ.































- Every sailor who races must be on a Crew Declaration
- RGYC Financial Member OR have a SailPass

- You can do your crew dec. days in advance
- You can resubmit as many times as you need if crew changes
- Troubleshooting is being added to the website under SAILPASS
- Get help from staff EARLY if you are having trouble



Safety Procedures

Boat Safety Procedures

Owners have a responsibility to make sure regular crew and visitors are aware of safety procedures and safety equipment on board.



Safety Procedures

IF YOU NEED EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE, CALL 000 IMMEDIATELY

Then notify the Race Committee



MAN OVERBOARD

Conditions of entry state:

A vessels owner, its skipper and its crew, agree & take sole responsibility...

To ensure the vessel is adequately prepared and its crew educated and regularly practiced in, and competent at, each vessels Man Overboard safety procedures, equipment and retrieval.

Compliance declaration is no longer required.



INSURANCE

Conditions of entry state:

A vessels owner, its skipper and its crew, agree & take sole responsibility...

To ensure vessel and its crew hold the correct and valid insurance, including third-party liability insurance to a minimum of 10-million AUD

Submission of insurance certificates are no longer required



INSURANCE

ENSURE YOUR VESSEL IS INSURED CORRECTLY, INCLUDING:

SPINNAKERS
SPEED LIMITS

Anchors on the bow are not permitted

40 PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES

40.1 BASIC RULE

Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.

NOTICE OF RACE 4.8

- **4.8.1** Audits are made by appointment from the Yacht Safe website with an AS Club Equipment auditor.
- **4.8.2** Boats without a current, valid equipment audit, may be scored DNC without a hearing.
