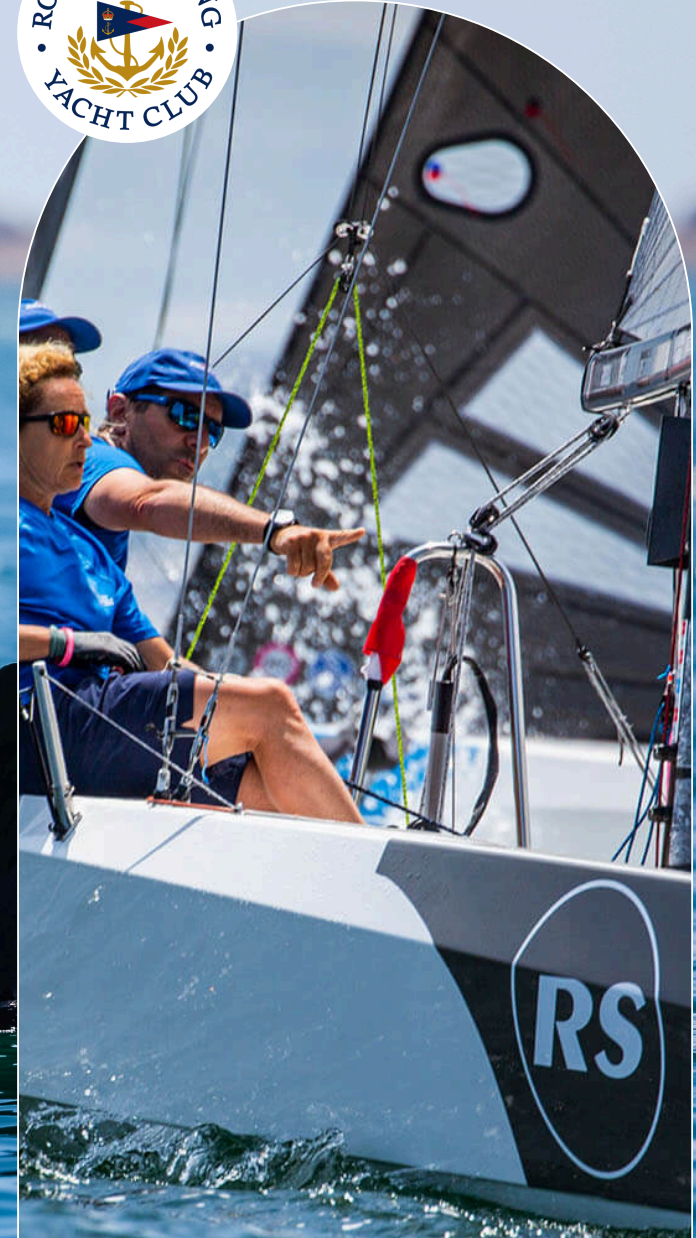

FAQS

No prior sailing or boating experience, Is necessary. It will be a new sport for most of the participants and is a fun activity for all ages and abilities providing a great team learning environment.

WHERE DO WE SAIL?

Boats are docked in the RGYC marina, and sailing will be on Corio Bay, right in front of the Geelong CBD. Instructors will assist in setting up the boats.

WHERE DO I KEEP MY VALUABLES WHILE SAILING?

All valuables and possessions are able to be securely stored while you are sailing. Each sailboat has limited dry storage although waterproof drybags will be provided to store cameras etc.

LIABILITY

Every participant must complete a liability waiver in order to participate in the event. Forms will be distributed for signing prior to the event.

SAFETY

All water sport activities entail an element of risk and it should be understood that each person participates at their own risk.

We make sure that our well-developed safety procedures are adhered to and our experienced instructors will conduct a safety briefing before each experience and note the dangers to watch out for.

All participants are required to wear lifejackets while on board the boats.

The consumption of alcohol and drugs is strictly prohibited before, and during all sailing activities.
